

DOT'S FRIENDS ADOPTION APPLICATION

Welcome to Dot's Friends! We are glad you have come to adopt a new pet from our rescue.

The following information is requested so that your adoption counselor can assist you in the selection of a new pet. The animal's welfare is our foremost consideration. The consultation process is designed to help us determine if the adoption is in the animal's best interest and to assist you in finding an animal most compatible with your lifestyle.

The animals available for adoption came here from a variety of sources. All animals are examined upon entry, and their health and behavior are routinely monitored while at the rescue. However, there is always a chance that an animal is incubating a disease without showing any clinical signs, or that an animal could have behavioral issues that are not immediately apparent. After a finalized adoption, any adopted animals are the sole responsibility of the adopter.

Our adoption fee helps cover the cost of: spay/neuter, microchip, first series of vaccinations, heartworm testing, fecal exam for parasites, initial monthly preventatives and any needed medication. The fee does not cover the cost of any treatment for illness or injury, nor does it cover the cost of training or transportation. Additional donations are welcome.

In order to be considered as an adopter, you must: Be 18 years of age or older; have identification showing your present address; obtain the knowledge and consent of your landlord (if applicable); be able and willing to spend the time and money necessary to provide training, medical treatment, and proper care for a pet; and agree in the event you can no longer care for the animal, you immediately return the animal to Dot's Friends.
